ROLE-SAFE RESULT

The account measures commodities associated
with Anuna. It does not make the Anuna millers,
carriers, accountants, or distributors; no finite
verb appears in the entry.

the allowed fallback and visibly prints A 181000.

EDITION TRANSLITERATION

CAUTIOUS WORKING TRANSLATION

Five sila of esha-flour, five sila of flour — Anuna.

VISIBLE · DAMAGED · RESTORED

Visible/unbracketed in the edition: both quantities, esza, zi3, the divine determinative, NUN, and NA.

Damaged-readable: A is marked a#.

Restored or supplied from parallels: none.

Class: exact_line_art_or_squeeze_visible. The exact copy verifies the row and preservation state, while the published CDLI lineation controls sign values. The reading is edition-guided, not an independent photographic decipherment.

Reverse 11-12: another measured entry

An Anuna compound divine name follows the commodity row

CAUTIOUS SENSE

Three sila of esha-flour, three sila of dabin-flour — Anuna-White-Eagle (compound divine name; normalization cautious).

LIMIT

The compound must not be silently flattened into the Anuna collective. The two-row sequence is nominal and has no finite verb. It documents an institutional allocation, not divine milling, transport, measurement, accounting, or technical instruction.

What surrounds the Anuna entry

Commodity, beneficiary, seal, human office, and date remain separate

OBV. 1-4

Flour and dates; then Šara of Apišal

FUNCTION / LIMIT Preceding allocation block and named divine beneficiary.

OBV. 5

5 sila esza · 5 sila zi3 · Anuna

FUNCTION / LIMIT Core measured nominal entry; A is damaged-readable; no verb.

REV. 19-20

ki Šara-kam-ta · kišib ensika

FUNCTION / LIMIT From Šara-kam; sealed by/with the governor's seal.

month e2-iti-6 · year Simanum destroyed

FUNCTION / LIMIT Ur III institutional date formula.

SEAL

Šū-Suen ... A'akalla, governor of Umma

FUNCTION / LIMIT Named king and human office-holder anchor the administrative act.

A second Ur III administrative comparison

Measured cult commodities are evidence of institution, not hidden technology

MAIN TAKEAWAY	OIM A181000 places Anuna in a measured flour-allocation sequence on a sealed Ur III Umma tablet.
COMPARISON	Like YBC 1078/P144821 and Hermitage 14708/P212025, this is non-literary evidence that Anuna language belonged to quantified institutional records.
NEW VALUE	This tablet adds multiple flour categories, a second Anuna compound, a governor's seal, month, regnal year, and named human office-holder on one exact object.
LIMIT / CONTRADICTION	Anuna is a nominal beneficiary or cultic referent, not the grammatical actor of a procedure. Human administration is explicit; divine technical agency is absent.
SITCHIN TEST	Moderate support for organized divine cult inside real administration; no evidence for extraterrestrials, genetics, spacecraft, mining, machinery, or advanced technology.

Reproducible evidence chain

Current CDLI metadata, ATF, exact copy, and agency-safe comparison

DAILY CAPABILITY IMPROVEMENT

Adds a beneficiary-to-actor firewall and second-account comparison matrix. For every administrative Anuna entry, record commodity, quantity, grammatical form, finite verb (or explicit absence), probable beneficiary/referent, source official, sealing official, institution, date, and image-reading mode. Never promote a divine name beside measured goods into the measurer, producer, carrier, accountant, or recipient unless the syntax states that role.
